## **YEAR 7 RELIGIOUS STUDIES TRIP – MONDAY 10 JANUARY/TUESDAY 11 JANUARY 2022**

As part of Year 7 Religious Studies, we have arranged an opportunity for all Year 7 students to visit **Preston Mosque (Masjid e Salaam)** and the **Southport Jewish Synagogue**. The visit will run over two days, with tutor groups 7A, 7B and 7C going on Monday, 10 January 2022 and tutor groups 7H, 7M and 7X going on Tuesday, 11 January 2022.

During the morning session, students will visit the Mosque and learn about its significance for Muslims as a place of worship. During the afternoon session at the Synagogue, students will learn about the features of the Synagogue as a Jewish place of worship and how these can be compared and contrasted with what students have seen at the Mosque earlier in the day. Students will be led by an Imam and Rabbi and supported by teachers from Bishop Rawstorne, including myself and other members of the Religious Studies department.

Students will depart from school after morning registration and return in time for the usual school buses at 3.00pm. School uniform must be worn. Students should bring a packed lunch or parents can email [office@bishopr.co.uk](mailto:office@bishopr.co.uk) if their child is entitled to and requires a free school lunch.

To assist with meeting the costs of the visit, we are requesting a payment of £9.00 per student. Please make payment on iPayimpact by following the link in the payment message or by going through the iPayimpact web site by Wednesday, 5 January 2022.

When payment is made online, we assume that you have provided implied consent and have agreed to the terms set out in the letter relating to this trip.

Any place offered on an educational visit is conditional and may subsequently be reviewed by the Senior Leadership Team of the Academy if a student's presence is identified as being potentially prejudicial to the health and safety of those participating in the visit.
