

BLACK HISTORY MONTH



Competition entries are invited from Primary age pupils Year 2 upwards.

The task is to create a poster celebrating Black History month. The poster can be themed generally around Black History, choose a specific black historical character who had a positive influence on history, history here in Blackpool or Lancashire, sports people/footballers of black heritage who have had wide reaching impact on society, the possibilities are endless.

This could be set as a topic for homework, task for a single class, phase or key stage or run by the school as part of the enhanced curriculum, celebrating diversity.

Posters must be no larger than A3 and can be created by an individual, pair or group. The school is to select it's best 5 posters to submit.

Entries must be received by the club no later than 18/10/2022 4pm. You can submit your entries to a member of Community Trust staff within your school or bring to the Club's main reception.

Posters will be displayed by the club online and on boards around the club site. The winning school will be notified by 21/10/2022.

All entering schools will receive a certificate of entry and involvement, signed by the football club.

The winning school will receive a visit from Blackpool first team players, the children will get the opportunity to interview the players about black history which will be shared on the Blackpool site.

The children will receive a Blackpool FC goody bag and the school will receive a signed football to use as they wish.

All entries must include on the back: Name and first line of address of the school, first name, year group and class.
