



# Gateway's Amazing Learning! Nursery and Reception Year 1 and 2

Another fantastic week in EYFS. We have begun our adventures with the Gruffalo in the Deep Dark Wood. It has been fantastic to see the children trying so hard with their RWI and watch them become increasingly independent with their writing.

Today we have made Gruffalo cakes with a science twist - we investigated how chocolate was a solid became a liquid and then became a solid again! Super learning with cake at the end - perfect!

This week in maths we have been exploring capacity and comparing different containers. In English we have been looking at a letter that Goldilocks wrote to apologise to the 3 bears and we have been thinking about times when we have had to say sorry. In history we created a timeline of different toys from the Victorians until now.

### Year 3 and 4

In Year 3 we have had a lovely week. We took part in a fun webinar with Jonny Duddle the illustrator for Harry Potter books. The children drew Hagrid by following along with Jonny. The pictures are brilliant. They were so proud of the end drawing. In maths we have been learning about place value. The children have been using place value counters and base 10 to support their learning.

In Year 4 the children had a great time finishing their art topic. They have created amazing artwork using 3D textiles and digital images. In maths we have been learning all about fractions and beginning to add two fractions together.

In writing the children have been looking at persuasive texts exploring all the different features and boxing up their own plan.

## Year 5 and 6

This week, Year 5 have continued to explore their persuasive T4W text 'Welcome to the School of Wizardry'. As part of our learning, the children have been locating features in persuasive texts and leaflets in order to support them with their writing. In maths, we have started our new topic on 'Geometry'. As part of this topic, we have been plotting coordinates and joining points on a grid. In Geography, the children have loved learning about the effects of volcanic eruptions and

they had the opportunity to display
their learning in the form of a
descriptive diary entry. In Year 6 the
children have enjoyed continuing with
times table Bingo, mapping out their
visit to Stanley Park and learning about
the Fibonacci Sequence.




For numbers to be counted, children will need to be writing in their home reading records for when they are reading at home and this will be entered onto our tracker.
