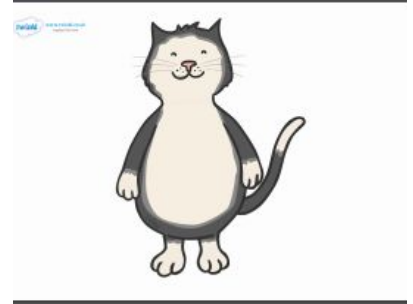
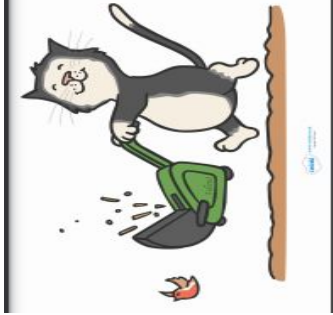
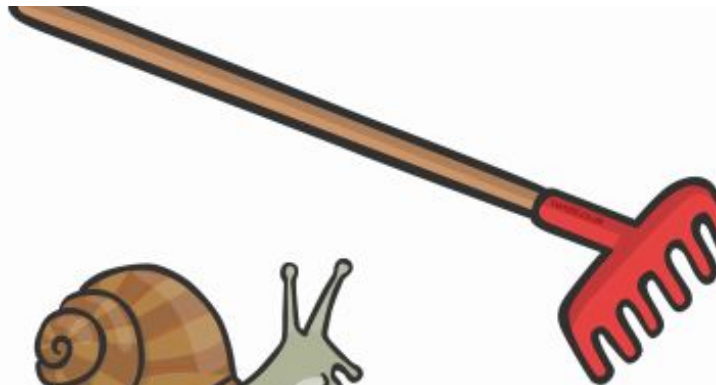


We're continuing with Jaspers Beanstalk. Recap the story with an adult.

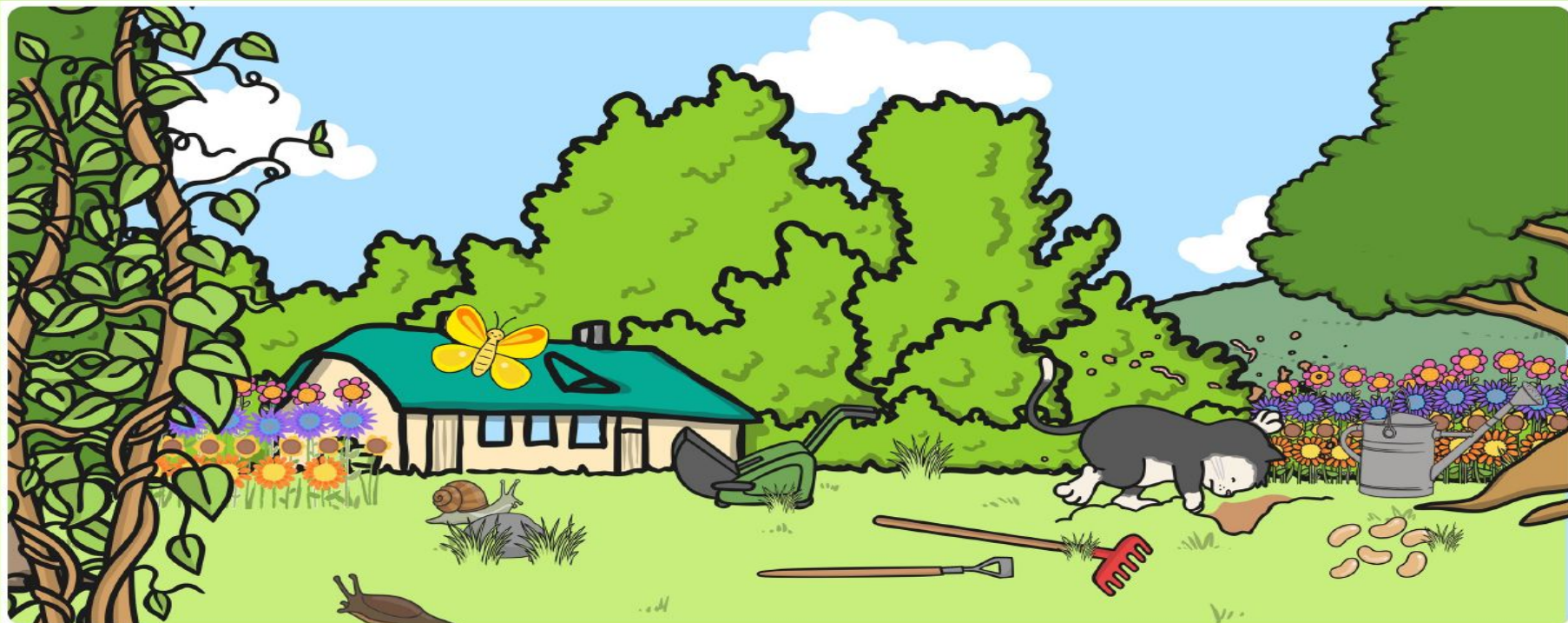

Can you find the objects shown at the bottom of the picture? Circle them in the picture.

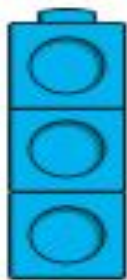

# Baa Baa Black Sheep

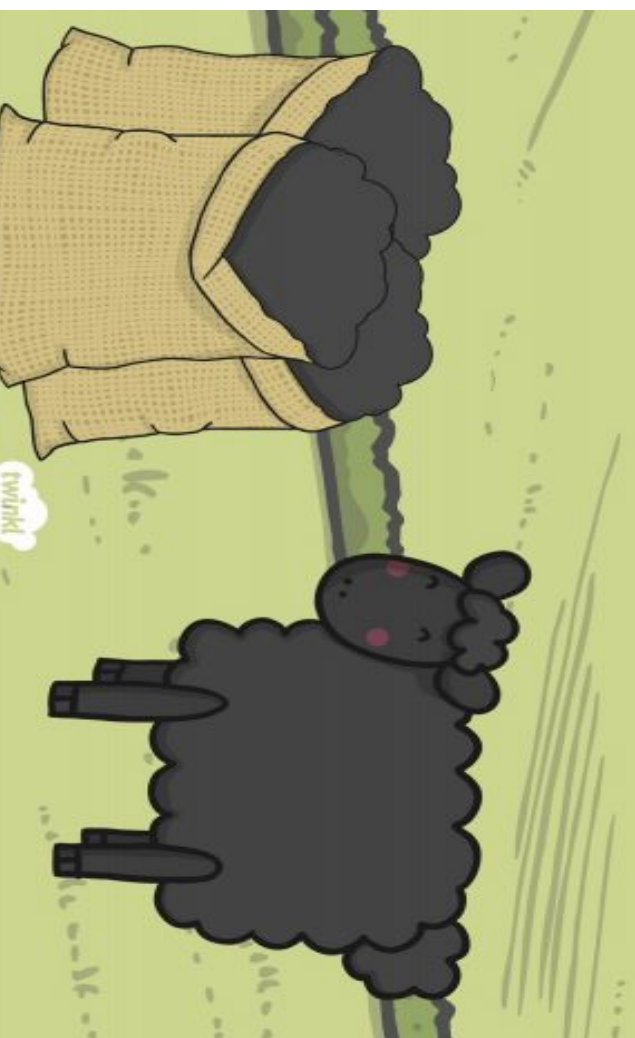
Baa baa black sheep,
