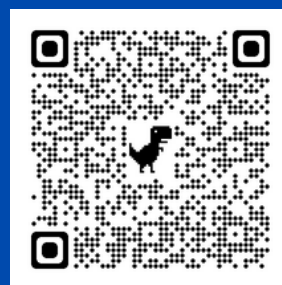
Important information

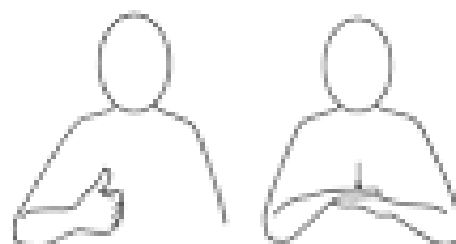

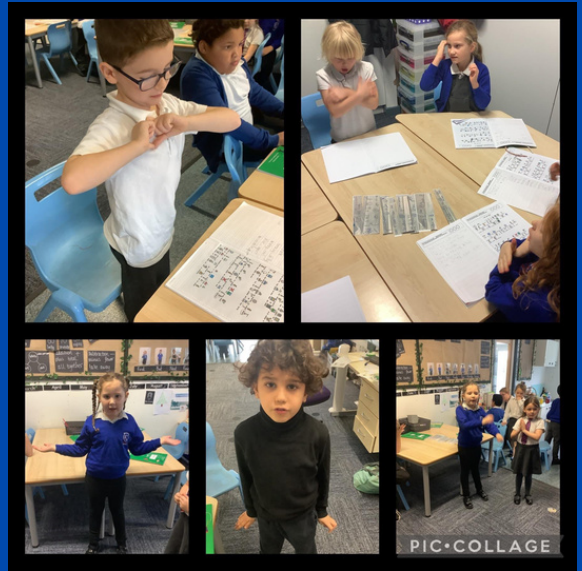
Year 4
