

For great attendance every fortnight, children will be sent a postcard home. If you receive a post card, bring it in to school for a reward from Mrs Riley.


This week 10 children will receive a postcard.

## **Learning at Gateway**

#### Nursery

Over the last two weeks, the children in Nursery have been learning all about Africa. We have been reading 'The Water Princess' and 'Hand's Surprise.' We have compared where the characters in the story live to where we live. We have been creating lots of beautiful African art work.

#### Year 1
