Year 6 have had a super two weeks and been busy in all their learning and enjoying OPAL Play areas.





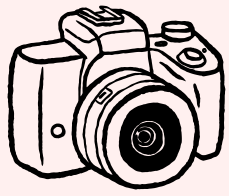
