Nursery

In Nursery over the last two weeks, we have been learning about different occupations. We have learnt lots of Makaton signs and been discussing what we want to be when we are older. We have enjoyed our transition days in our new classroom and meeting some of our new friends. Have a lovely weekend.

Reception

The children have been exploring different occupations and had some special visitors in to explain what their job are. We've enjoyed talking about what we want to be when we grow up. In maths we looked at different capacity using our new vocabulary, full, half full, half empty and empty. Have a great weekend.

Year 1

In Year 1 we have been busy learning about capacity and volume. We have completed practical maths lessons using correct mathematical language to describe the volume of different containers. In English, we have been designing our own aliens in readiness of writing our own narrartives stories based on Beegu. Whilst in DT we have begun making our own moving vehicles - they are amazing!

Year 2

In Year 2, we completed money in Maths and understood the importance of change and brought this into our understanding of this in PSHE when we need to go to the shops for things we need rather than want on a budget. After showcasing some spectacular writing pieces with our innovative story about nocturnal animals we transitioned into some non-fiction and started to look into writing information pieces about nocturnal animals- this will link well into our food chain understanding in Science.

Year 3

Year 3 have been enjoying investigating the properties of 3D shapes this week in maths. In Science, we have been investigating the permeability of different rocks through practical experimentation.

Year 4

In Year 4, we have recently completed our work on Geometry, including translating coordinates with increasing confidence. In Design and Technology, we thoroughly enjoyed designing and making our own popup books. In Science, we have been exploring food chains across a range of habitats and learning how producers, predators and prey are connected. In English, we are currently writing setting descriptions inspired by a short story, focusing on using rich vocabulary to create atmosphere. Finally, in our swimming lessons this week, several children achieved impressive milestones by swimming 10m, 25m, and even 50m — a fantastic achievement!

Year 5

In Year 5, we have been revisiting converting units, including kilograms to grams and litres to millilitres. We have just finished our class novel which the children have thoroughly enjoyed and we re looking forward to moving onto Kensuke's Kingdom in our writing journey. The children have thoroughly enjoyed looking at and comparing a variety of different life cycles in Science as well.

Year 6 have been enjoying the new OPAL Play resources and setting up for their own Science Museum.
