Nursery

We have had a lovely first week back, this week we are reading the story Room on the Broom. We are also learning a new rhythm to retell the story and practicing our Makaton signs as the actions. We have had a sneak peek at the Nativity today, it really is the most wonderful term of the year.

Reception

What a great return to Reception! the children have been busy learning new sounds in RWInc and retelling the story of 'Room On A Broom.' In maths we have learnt the concept of 4 and subitising groups of objects. This is a very busy half term in Reception and we have now started learning our songs for our Christmas Nativity. Year 1

Year 1 have had a busy first week back! We have been writing sentences about our superhero 'Toy Man' whilst in maths, we have been investigating fact families. Year 2

A wonderful first week back after the half term. The children were very exctied to share their October half term news. This week, the children have been working really hard understanding what a riddle is and preparing to write their own riddles next week. We have been using tens/ones and place value mats to help us add and subject numbers. Well done Year 2 - always proud!

Year 3

Year 3 are having a great week back and kicked off the half term by writing some fantastic haiku poems. In Maths they have been continuing their hardwork with addition and subtraction and have made a great start at understanding column method. They have loved learning about magnets in Science and have been using some great scientific langauge e.g. attract, repel.

Year 4

Year 4 have had a fantastic first week back. In Science, we have been popping balloons to investigate the properties of solids, liquids and gases. We have been multiplying and dividing by 10 and 100 in our maths lessons. We have been exploring the water cycle in Geography and introduced our festive design topic in DT.

Year 5 have had a fantastic week back and we have hit the ground running! We have started our writing journey based on poems and have started our new topic in maths of multiplication and division. Some very resilient and inqusitive learning in Year 5 this week!









