"Hi I'm Adam and I would like to bridge the gap between students and teachers. I want to make this year unforgettable and try my best to do all the jobs assigned for me."

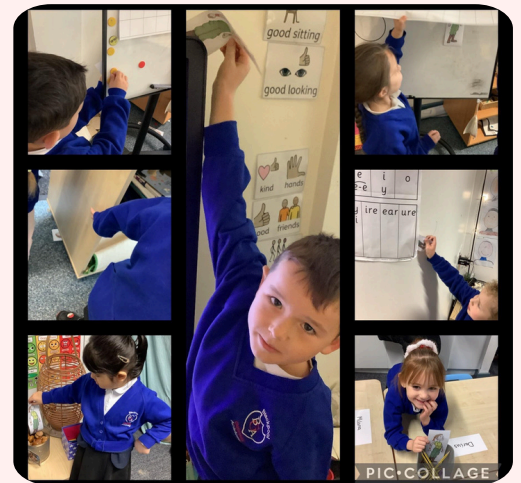
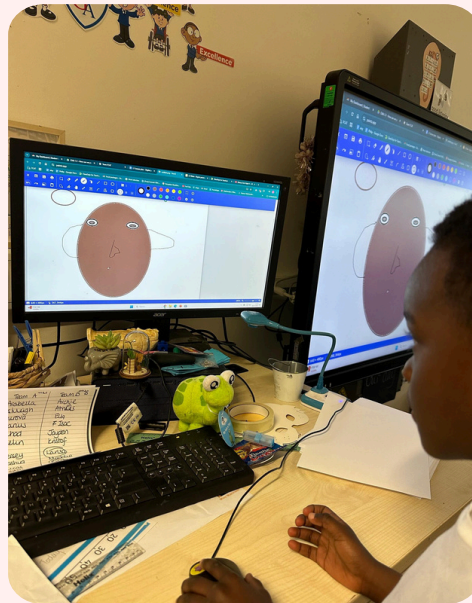
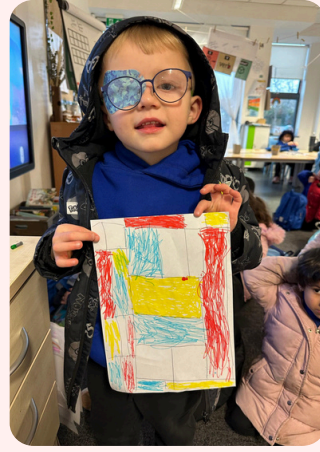
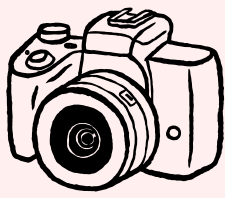
