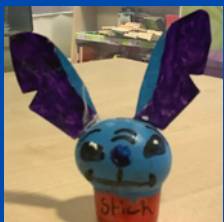
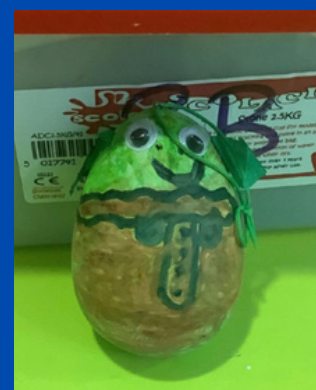
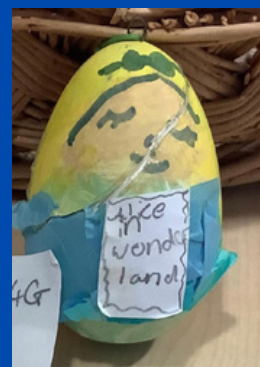

Year 2 have enjoyed the last week of our term. We hope you all have a lovely half term break.

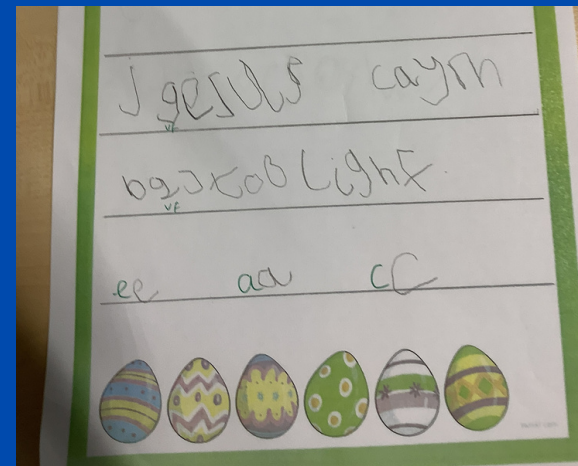
Year 4
