

This week in Nursery we have been finishing off our story of the Gingerbread Man. Using our story map, we have sequenced the story and even created our own little Gingerbread Men using salt dough. We are very excited to be starting Christmas next week and we have had a lovely week welcoming the new Nursery Teacher, Miss Clancy.

## Year 2

Year 2 this week have loved finishing making their puppets and cannot wait to bring them home. Also, they have tried very hard with dividing and it would be great for them to begin playing the division facts for 2, 5 and 10 at home on the Hit the button too. Keep up the hard work Year 2! Year3 this week have been looking at multiplying and dividing by eight in maths. In English, we have written a letter from jail, from the wolf, pleading our innocence from crimes against Little Red Riding Hood, as we begin our final text of this term. In science we have continued our investigations into 'Forces' discovering which surfaces are magnetic and which are not, whilst in geography we have been learning about different climate zones. Our learning continues too in music, PE, French and PSHE. Next week we are tasting, designing and making our own sandwiches in D.T!

In Year 4 at swimming the children have been learning their vital life saving skills and have impressed us with their resilience. In writing we have been learning how to write instructions as we believe Santa has come to Blackpool for his holidays but is reluctant to go back to the North Pole. We will keep let you know if we are able to successfully write a set of instructions on how to trap Santa!

In English, Year 5 have been exploring the instruction text, how to make a witches' potion. They have found synonyms for words and learnt the text. In Maths, we

have been finding the perimeter of rectangles. Also, in Dt we have been learning how to make an automata toy.

In Year 6, we have been learning about suspense writing techniques and how we can apply these to our own writing. Our week has also involved converting metric and imperial measures in Maths, whilst in Science we prepared for an exciting experiment using torches. It has been a fun week of learning in Year 6.
