

Reading for Pleasure




With reading being one of our key priorities, we wanted to share some of our favourite authors and books that we love to read for pleasure.

Nursery and Reception

Year 5 and 6


In Y5/6 this week, we have concluded some exciting work on electrical circuits, continued our learning about volcanoes and produced some great innovative and independent pieces of writing.


