Can you retell the story using the story map? Today we are going to read the Happy poem. Can you clap to it. Can you join in. Can you write a sentence about what makes you happy?</p>	<p>Can I remember? Last week we investigated doubling numbers - can you remember how to do it? Can you share them with another person? Make sure you have the same amount</p>

Topic - Superheroes		Dough Disco
<p>Last week we looked at all the people who help us. For the next few days we are going to be looking at superheroes and their powers. What superheroes do you know? Can you design your own superhero? Can you make a mask or cape to wear for tomorrow's live session? If you have a costume you can come dress up as a superhero!</p>		<p>Dough Disco is a great activity for helping us to develop our fine motor skills. It strengthens the muscles in our hands and develops our hand-eye co-ordination which will later enable us to hold a pencil correctly and use it effectively.  <p>Everyday a link will be sent home to you via your coloured Dojo group</p>	<p>Read our story using our actions and story map. Listen to the letter from Mavis's best friend:</p> <p>Dear Mavis, I made the best magical potion ever yesterday! It had our favourite things in it! It had some spiders, leaves, mud, water and lots more in it! Can you make your own magical potion too? From Your best friend!</p> <p>Can you make your own potion using things from your house? You might use glitter, water, food colouring, leaves from your garden or anything that you think could make your potion magical! Can you write a list of all the ingredients you used?</p>	<p>Can I still?</p> <p>Count to 10 forwards and backwards.</p> <p>Main Lesson</p> <p>Recap halving - sharing into two equal groups.</p> <p>Introduce how we can share items. Folded piece of paper - sharing out objects equally into halves.</p>
