PSHE

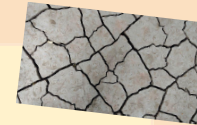
Our PSHE lessons will cover Health and Wellbeing, Relationships, and Living in the Wider World

Science

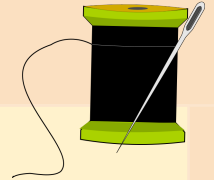
This term, we will be focusing on *Electricity*, exploring how circuits work and understanding electrical components.
