All your tasks have been set for you on Google Classrooms. The tasks that you will be completing are:

Monday - I am learning to internalise a story.

Tuesday - I am learning to sequence a story.
Wednesday - I am learning to describe characters.
Thursday - I am learning to write a simple sentence.
Friday - I am learning to write a simple sentence.

Bronze Challenge: I would like you to draw a picture of the story and label it.
Silver Challenge: I would like you to write the beginning part.
Gold Challenge: I would like you to rewrite the story.

Remember to use capital letters, full stops and finger spaces!
