sentences using capital letters and full stops correctly. We will also be developing the use of adjectives within our writing and the use of conjunctions.


Maths >>>

Humanities and Science

Geography: Our topics are: Around the World and Blackpool in the past. Our key learning questions will be: Where would you prefer to live? England or Africa?

What was it like in Blackpool during the 1900's?

Science: Our topics are Animals including humans and Living things and their habitats. The children will learn to:

-notice that animals, including humans, have offspring which grow into adults

-find out about and describe the basic needs of animals, including humans, for survival (water, food and air) and the importance of exercise, hygiene and a balanced diet.

-compare the differences between things that are living, dead, and things that have never been alive

-identify that most living things live in habitats to which hey are suited and describe how different habitats meet the needs of animals or plants.
