How can I help my child's learning at home?

<u>Writing</u>



Throughout the Summer term, we will continue to be using 'Talk for Writing' as a stimulus for delivering our writing units.

We will be exploring a variety of fiction and non-fiction texts, concentrating on various punctuation and grammar skills relevant to the genre, including:

Creating complex sentences with adverb starters.

Identifying, selecting and using determiners.

Use books from the library or the internet to help your child find out more about these

<u>Reading</u>

Throughout the Summer term, we will continue to be using a range of fiction and non-fiction texts to improve our reading skills. In particular, we will continue to focus on an increased fluency in reading aloud, the use of punctuation to aid expression, identifying key features of texts, and beginning to be able to express opinions, providing evidence to support these.

<u>PE</u>

During the Summer term, will be developing the fundamental skills of balance and movement through gymnastics. Blackpool Gateway Academy

<u>Maths</u>

This term we will be covering different aspects of maths, integrating problem solving and skills wherever possible.

The main topics that will be covered are:

- Number: Multiplication and Division, Addition and subtraction.
- Measurement: Money
- Statistics

Science and Technology

Science: As scientists this term we will be learning about living things and their habitats. We will be exploring: classification keys, the characteristics of living things and positive and negative changes in our local environment.

We will be exploring: how to create a product that uses both electrical and mechanical components.

Religious Education (RE)
