How can I help my child's learning at home?

Writing

Humanities

This term we will be covering different aspects of maths, integrating problem solving and skills wherever possible.

The main topics that will be covered are:

- Place Value

Science and Technology

Science: In Spring 1 we will be learning about Forces, moving onto Changes in Materials in Spring 2.

DT: In Spring 2 we will be researching Mexican food and tasting a range of traditional Mexican foods before creating our own dish

Computing: Autumn 1 begins with exploring spreadsheets and their uses before creating our own games using ,'Game creator'.

Geography: During Spring 1 we will be starting a Geography unit on Volcanoes. The key question is: 'What's inside a volcano?' We will be exploring: what a volcano is. identifying features, naming famous volcanoes and their impact on the environment. History: During Spring 2 we will be learning about the Ancient Egyptians. The key question will be, 'Who were the Ancient Egyptians and what can we learn from them?'. We will be exploring: Who the Ancient Egyptians were, when they lived in History, What their daily lives were like, gods and goddesses and important events.

The 'Arts'

Music – We begin the Spring term focusing on the pop song, 'Make you feel my love' by Adele. Then, we will move onto 'French Prince of Bel Air', where various different musical skills are improved using this well-known song. Art - We will be exploring the famous artist, 'Henri Rousseau' as part of our topic on Rainforests. We will be researching the work of this famous artist before planning and creating our own pieces of Art inspired by him.

Religious Education (RE)

During Spring 1 Year 5 will be learning about Sikhism. The key question is 'Are Sikh stories important today

In Spring 2, we will move on to exploring Christianity and the key question will be 'How significant is it that Christians believe that God intended Jesus to die?'
