

# Gateway's Amazing Learning! Nursery and Reception Year 1 and 2

We have had a very exciting week in EYFS. The children were very excited when Farmer Dave delivered some eggs to us on Tuesday. We all made predictions about what could be inside and from baby chickens to dinosaurs! ### Year 3 and 4

This week in Year 3 we have been very ingeniously innovating our text in English - by changing some of the characters, we have created a whole new suspense, warning story, whilst in science, we explored the properties of rocks, examining which ones were more dense, which were permeable, which were durable and if we thought they were hard or soft - we loved being scientists and finding out about why rocks, ROCK!! What a busy week in Year 5 and 6. Well done to all our Year 6 children who have been working hard on the mock SATS.


