Year three has had a super week this week, and really impressed our Ofsted inspectors when they came to see us in Geography, when we were discussing the human and physical effects of the Olympic Games when they were held in Rio as part of our topic of Brazil. We have looked at temperature and made a human thermometer in maths and finished our nonfiction information texts about all sorts of incredible creatures in English. We also had a fabulous day celebrating The Queen's Platinum Jubilee with a street parade and then ice-cream and a disco outside making memories that will last a lifetime.

In English Year 4 have been planning their own invention based on our explanation text, The Teacher Pleaser. In maths this week we have continued to investigate money with a focus on rounding and estimating amounts. In Science we have been out in the school grounds collecting invertebrates and then creating keys to classify them. 
#### **Queens Jubilee**
