


Year 1 and 2

Year 1 enjoyed creating their lighthouses this week and writing the story The Lighthouse Keeper's Lunch. In geography we have been learning about the Union Jack flag and how it is made as well as using an atlas to identify the countries.

Year 2 had a brilliant day at Blackpool tower this week! As well as going to the top of the tower we watched a show in 3D, ate our dinner in the Ballroom watching people dance and we enjoyed a nice walk down the promenade looking at all the different attractions. Year 3 and 4

What a week in Year 3. We have had a visit from King Henry VIII in History and we were able to ask him lots of super questions. We have been learning about 'The Battle of Bosworth' and the 'Wars of the Roses' in our reading lessons, racing cars and testing out different surfaces and friction in science.

Another week of amazing learning.

This week in Maths, Year 4 has been investigating geometry of 2D shapes with a focus on symmetry. In Science we have been planting Poppy seeds as part of our plant investigation where we will monitor their growth over time. Geography this we has all been about investigating the importance of the Amazon rainforest. In both Reading and Writing lessons this week we have been exploring the use of vocabulary to engage the reader in our 'defeating the monster' tale, Simic and the Forest.

We have all been practicing for Sports Day. We hope lots of adults can come and support us on Tuesday and see us show off our PE skills.

Year 5 and 6

Year 5 have been very busy this week engaging with their new Talk for Writing text, 'The Canal. As part of this, we have; created a box up of the text and explored vocabulary to use in our own writing. In Maths, we have been exploring turns and angles.

As part of this unit, we have identified right angles, acute and obtuse angles in shapes.

This week has been a very busy one in Year 6: the children have completed their pop art designs and started to look at wire sculptures; many have completed their bikeability course; they've continued to look at the development of the UK and also started to have conversations around transition to high school.


