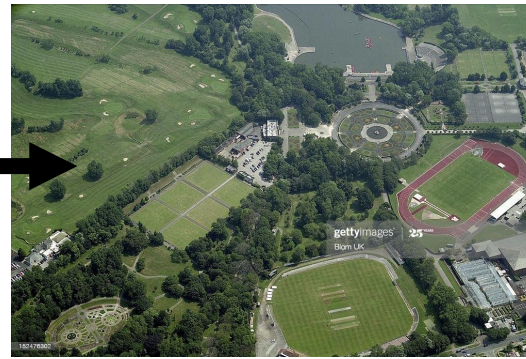


You will need:

- Landscape image sheet
- Artist image sheet (choose 1)
- A3 paper
- Materials: pencil, pen, crayons, pastel or paint.

1. Look at the landscape.
2. Sketch out the main shapes, filling the A3 page. Simplify the image into shapes.
3. Now work into the image in the style of the example artwork you chose... i.e. if you picked the Australia map you might add blocks of colour so it looks like a patchwork. If you picked the cream coiled artwork you might pencil shade your drawing – looking at tone.



Which of the **FORMAL ELEMENTS** can you see in the artwork you chose:

Form
Colour
Texture
Shape
Line
Pattern
Composition
Tone

This task leads on from the last.

You are working in the style of the artists so use the same colours, textures.

We are looking at Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Art for inspiration to create pieces linking to our own 'Land' and 'Country' in the way that they do.
