We're nearing the end of the half term and have so many fantastic students to celebrate in this newsletter. This academic year so far, we have 90 students that have received 0 behaviour points – a huge well done to these students who each day show perfect conduct both in and out of the classroom. For the month of January, 158 students have not received a consequence at all – this is something to celebrate, well done ©

We also have 21 resilient students with 100% attendance since we returned in September.

Our key message again remains the same. Attendance in this year group is not at the standard that it needs to be, and this has a direct impact on the progress made with regards to learning.

The year group as a whole has 84.7% attendance which falls drastically short of the expected 97%+. It is absolutely paramount that this improves so that your child makes the progress throughout this academic year, to stand them in good stead ahead of their GCSE years.
