Happy December!

We're nearing the end of the first full term and have so many fantastic students to celebrate in this newsletter. This academic year so far we have 104 students that have received 0 behaviour points – a huge well done to these students who each day show perfect conduct both in and out of the classroom. We also have 38 resilient students with 100% attendance.

Our key message again remains the same. Attendance in this year group is not at the standard that it needs to be, and this has a direct impact on the progress made with regards to learning. Throughout November, the year group as a whole had 84.9% attendance which falls drastically short of the expected 97%+. It is absolutely paramount that this improves so that your child makes the progress throughout this academic year, to stand them in good stead ahead of their GCSE years.
