As you will know the Year 11s will be completing English and Maths mocks the second week back after half term (2nd/3d March English and 4th/5th/6th March Maths). With this in mind we thought it best to take the opportunity to remind both parents and students of the support available to them in preparation for these assessments.

During this final week Maths and English teachers are delivering revision sessions in their lessons before we break up. Intervention lessons are geared to maximise progress from the PPEs sat in November, targeting crucial areas within the subject curriculum. On Thursday 12th February the Maths team are delivering a 'How to Revise' Lesson 6 workshop in the hall which focuses on how to close the revision loop, whilst sharing proven maths revision strategies. This concentrates on students' fluency and what specific/best topics to revise. This will be a very worthwhile session to attend!

Lesson 6 continues to run every night of the week and students have their own individual priority lesson 6 timetable. These sessions focus on and target topics where individuals, groups or classes are underperforming. Also, each lesson 6 attended equals money off the Prom Ticket so make sure you have a Passport to Prom. Additionally, starting next half term, for every lesson 6 attended we will add your name to the Year 11 Lottery which will be drawn every Friday in assembly.
