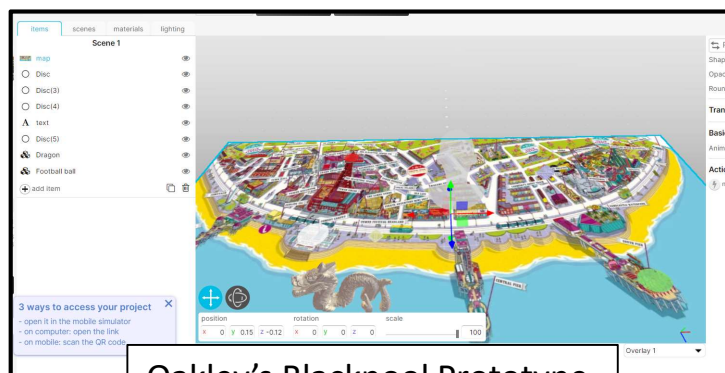

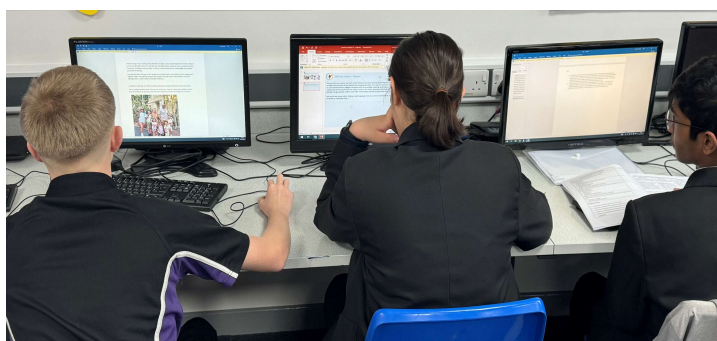
The postman has been busy making deliveries of our success postcards. The team nominate two students from each class. Congratulations if you have received a card.

The Year 10 Digital Technology class have been learning how to create AR prototypes using XR+. This is in preparation for the group starting their second piece of Controlled Assessment after half term.

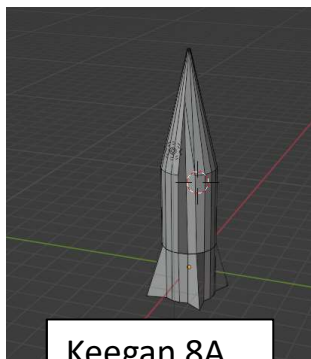
The Year 10 Business class have been focusing on how they are going to market the ice cream they have designed. The groups have been thinking of branding ideas including some unique straplines and logos.

Year 8 have been focused on designing and creating their adverts using the animation software Blender.



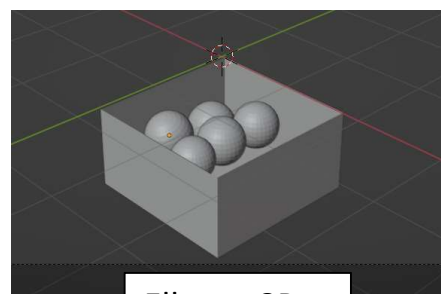
