


The postman has been busy making deliveries of our success postcards. The team nominate two students from each class. Congratulations if you have received a card.

I chose to use vanilla flavoured ice cream as it is filled by the majority of the people that completed my questionnaire.







As we finish our quizzes, the students are going to add some cell protection as well as a macro button that will reset the quiz.


