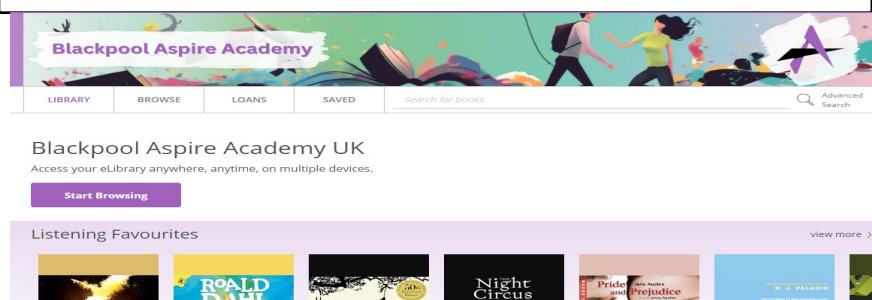
Myths and Legends!
