Siobhan Collingwood has been headteacher of a Primary school in Morecambe, Lancashire for 14 years. Morecambe is a coastal town with pockets of extreme deprivation from which the school's intake is drawn. The school has established outstanding Pastoral Support systems and makes excellent use of links with other agencies and sectors.

Siobhan works as a member of the County LSCB on projects to improve multi-agency practice, and on her local mental health transformation plan steering group. She contributes articles for TES on mental health and educational issues and gave written and verbal evidence to the recent joint Education and Health Parliamentary Inquiry into the role of schools in promoting positive mental health for children and young people.
