Reading/Homework

Please help support your child by completing all homework and reading tasks and returning them to school on time. Please read with your child every night. Although they might not be ready to read the words themselves it is important that they see words being read and they get familiar with books. Encourage your child to talk about the pictures and events in the story.

Your child will receive their homework on a Thursday and this must be returned on Monday. Your child will also be given some sound cards and key words to learn each week to support their phonics.

WOW work

Your child's learning journey through the foundation stage can be greatly supported by you. We would like to know about what they have been doing at home and every few week you will receive 'What I have been doing' sheets that we would like you to complete as often as possible.
