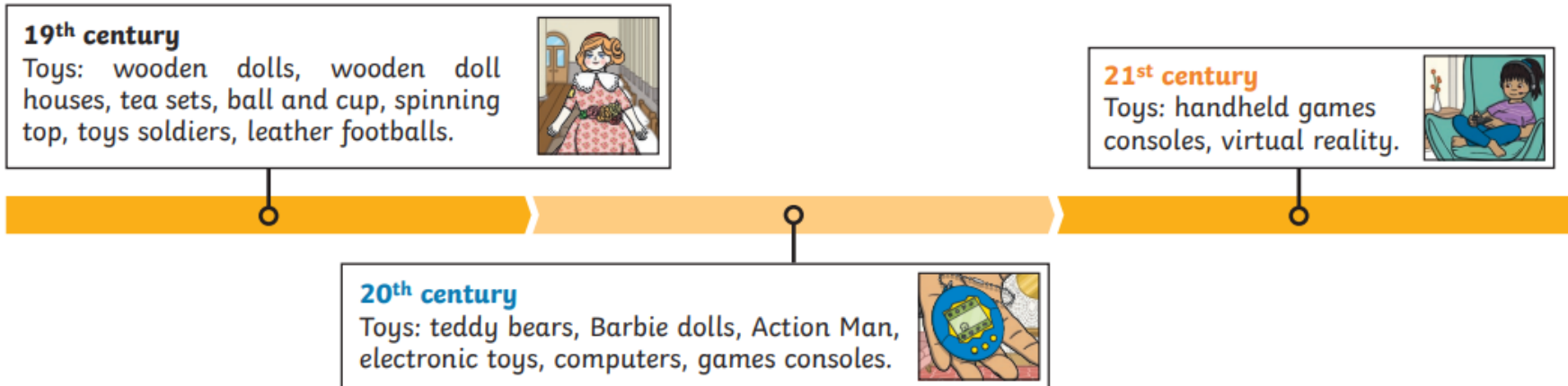


Old vs New
