## Autumn Term 1

We would like to welcome our new and returning students to Reception. We hope that you have had a lovely summer and your child is excited to be starting Reception. We are looking forward to getting to know you better and exploring our new classrooms together.

<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Topic</b></p> <p style="text-align: center;">What do I know about me?</p> <p>This half term we will be exploring ways that we are the same and different to people around us. We will also be thinking about our own families and comparing them to other families.</p> <p>Also, we will explore where we come from and compare our lives to other people around the world. We will look at our homes and the homes of other people around the world.</p> <p>We would ask that you send over your family's heritage on ClassDojo to your teacher for the upcoming topic, as well as any relevant pictures. Also, anything interesting that you know about your culture.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>English</b></p> <p>This half term we will be looking at a variety of books linked to our whole class topic. These books will include <i>The Colour Monster</i>, <i>Whiffy Wilson</i> and <i>The Smeds and the Smoos</i>.</p> <p><i>We will explore different books and discuss key events in stories. The children will learn about the different features of a book, such as the title, author and illustrator. We will also discuss different characters thoughts and feelings at specific events in stories. We encourage children to share their thoughts on books so that we can better understand the types of books that they enjoy engaging with.</i></p>
<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Phonics</b></p> <p>In phonics this half term we will continue to explore the 7 aspects of phase 1 phonics. These aspects are:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Environmental sounds</b></li> <li>• <b>Instrumental sounds</b></li> <li>• <b>Body sounds</b></li> <li>• <b>Rhythm and rhyme</b></li> <li>• <b>Alliteration</b></li> <li>• <b>Voice sounds</b></li> <li>• <b>Oral blending and segmenting</b></li> </ul> <p>We will begin to introduce Phase 2 phonics sounds. We follow a scheme 'Rocket Phonics'. Your child will receive phonics flashcards for homework. Please support your child by practising these sounds at home.</p> <p><a href="https://www.phonicsbloom.com/uk/game/list/phonics-games-phase-1">https://www.phonicsbloom.com/uk/game/list/phonics-games-phase-1</a> has fun games that your child can play online to help them with this at home.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Mathematics</b></p> <p>In mathematics this half term we will look at comparing and sorting into different groups. We will be exploring objects that are the same and objects that are different and grouping them.</p> <p>We will then progress onto looking at patterns. We will start by looking at simple AB repeating patterns, such as red, blue red, blue, and extend these patterns. Once the children have secured this, we will progress onto ABC repeating patterns, such as red, blue, green, red, blue, green. The children will focus on finding and extending these patterns.</p> <p>We will also be exploring circles and triangles. We will find these in our environment and explore the properties of each of the shapes.</p> <p>Number blocks is a useful tool to assist your child in their understanding of numbers. These can be found on BBC iPlayer.</p>
<p>Now the weather is getting colder please ensure your child has a warm waterproof coat, hat and gloves in school every day. Please label everything with your child's name.</p> <div data-bbox="71 1691 199 1803" data-label="Image"></div> <p>We also have a large number of children who haven't brought in a pair of wellington boots. Please remember to read with your child every night. Your child needs repetition to be able to begin reading on their own. To begin with your child will receive a reading book with no words, please discuss the pictures in the story and ask your child the questions at the back of the book to develop their understanding.

Your child will receive a Library book and this will be changed weekly. You can share this library book with your child and discuss what has happened in the book and try to predict what will happen next.

Please bring their book bag into school every day.
