Getting to know me



This term we are going to find out all about your child and how their interests have changed since we last saw them. They are also going to meet their new class members and start to get to know them too. We will explore our bodies and use our senses to smell, taste, hear, feel and see. We will be listening to lots of body songs (these will be shared with you via class dojo) whilst we learn about the different parts of our body. We will end the term with a Halloween topic, where the children will explore pumpkins and other Halloween items.

English and Maths

In English we will focus on the nursery rhymes of Incy Wincy Spider, Patter Cake and Twinkle Twinkle Little Star. We will explore key vocabulary and use props and actions to support our learning of the songs. In Maths we will focus on numbers to 5 and learn about taking one away through songs. Using familiar songs will help to improve their learning.



Things to Remember

- any snacks or lunch you are providing,
