We smell with our nose.

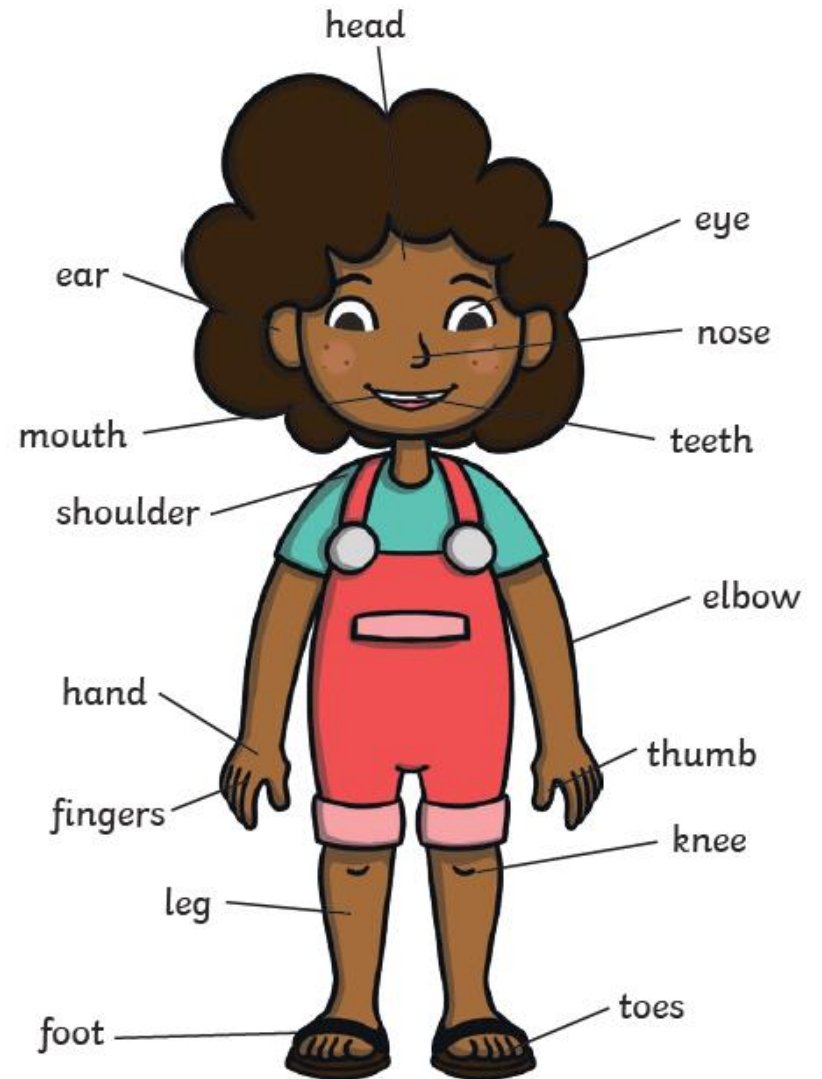


We can **taste**.

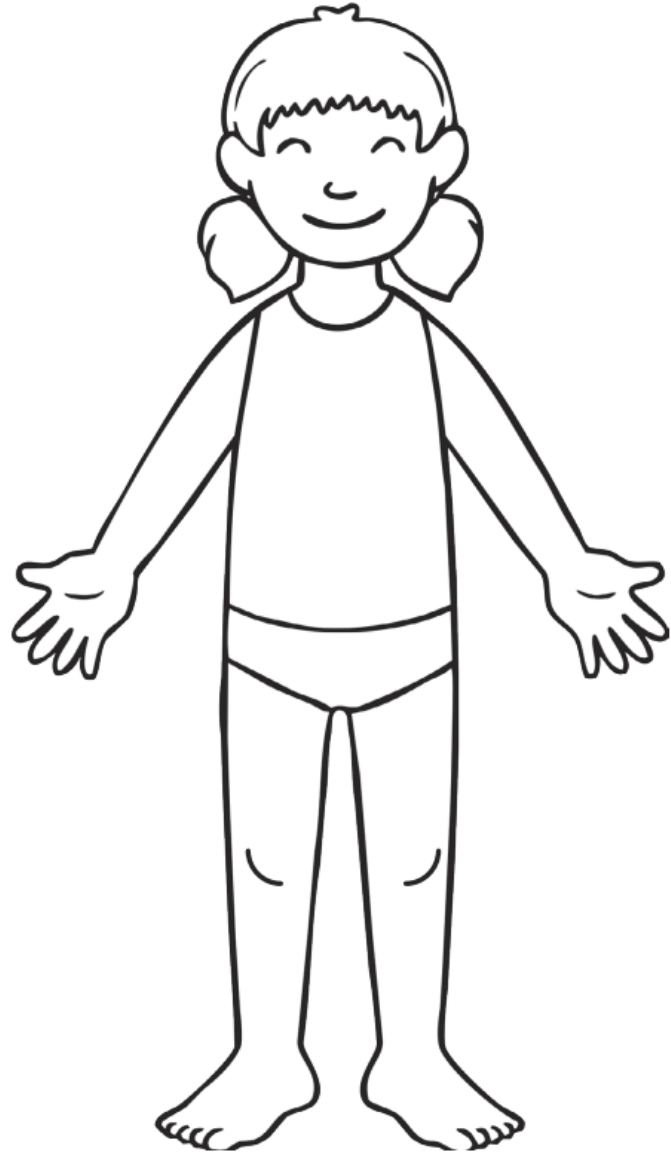

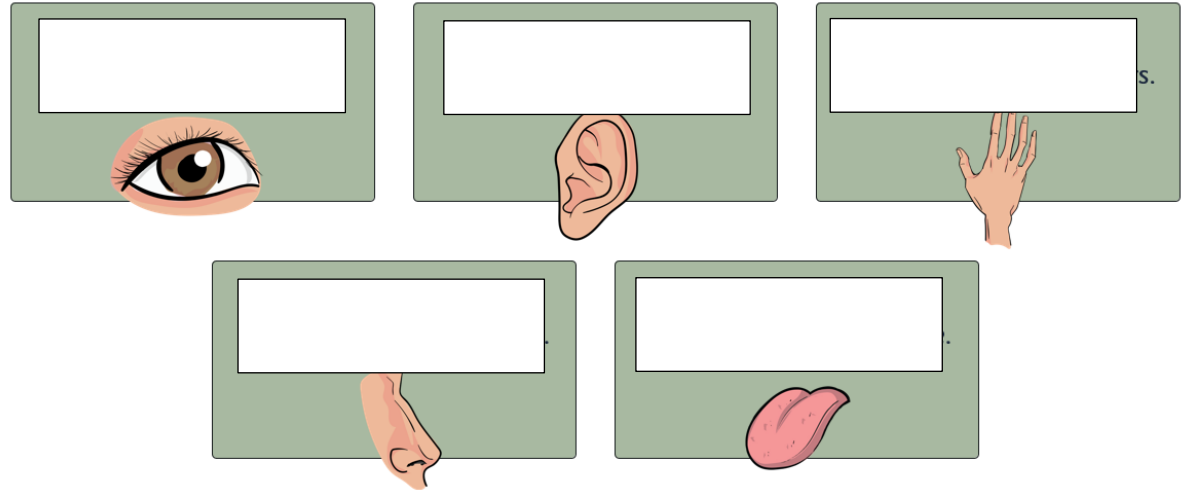
