

What should I already know?

- The four seasons, **Autumn**, **Winter**, **Spring**, **Summer**,
- During **autumn** the leaves fall off the trees,
- In **winter** it is cold,
- In **spring** the leaves start to grow back,
- In **summer** the sun shines more and it becomes hotter.

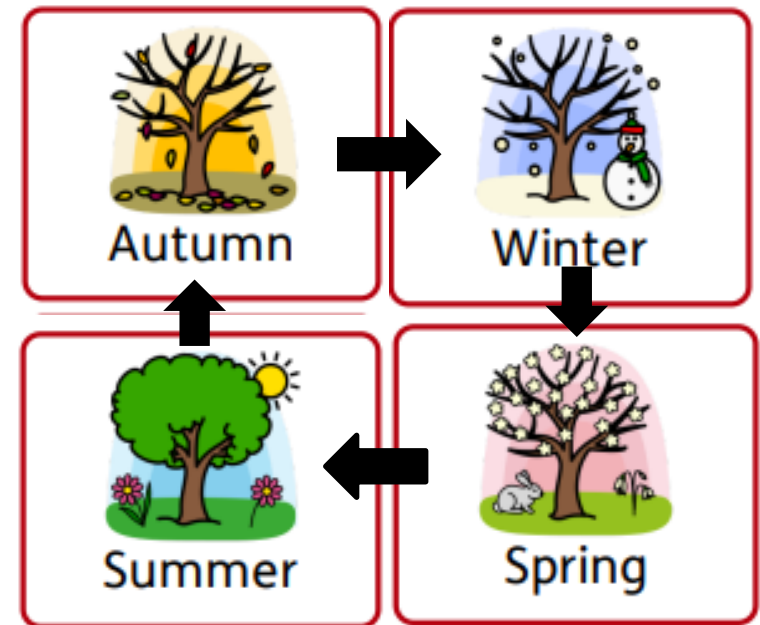
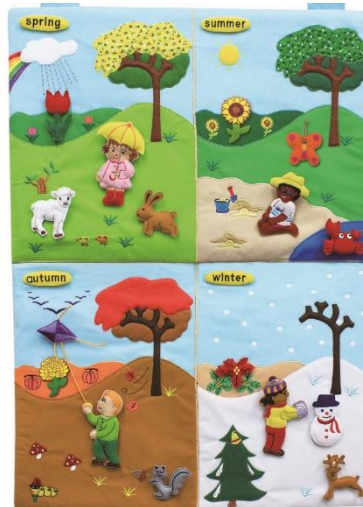
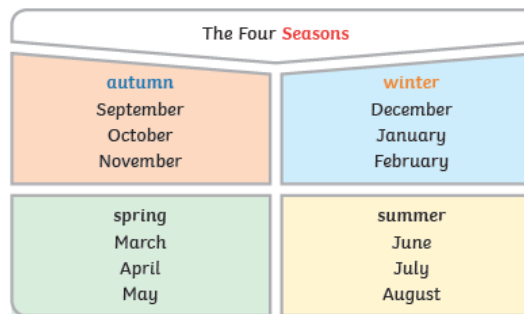
Weather – The weather is what is happening outside, e.g. rain, snow, sun.

Night time – Night time is when it is dark outside.

Temperature – How cold or hot it feels.
