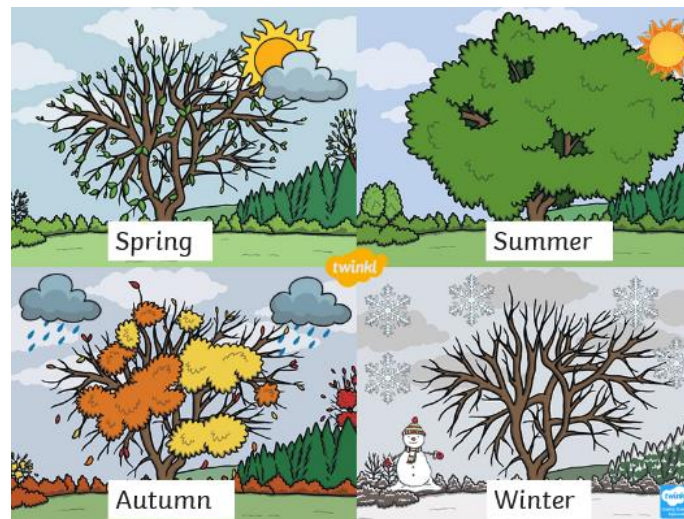
This is the country where we live.



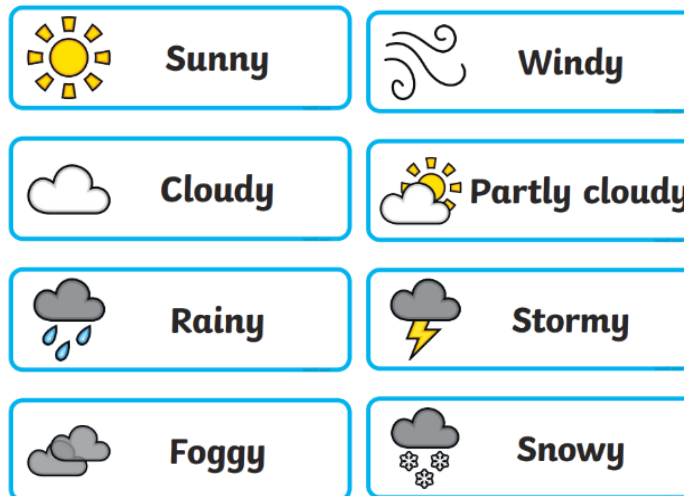
I live in the United Kingdom. I live in England.
