Homework: Spelling homework will be Spelling Shed. The children should login Monday until Thursday night to complete activities. Times tables rock stars will be the weekly maths homework which children should complete daily to practice their timetables knowledge. **This is especially important in Year 4 as the children will undertake a statutory assessment this term.** .

What are we learning?

During Summer 2 the focus will be history and the children will be learning about the Ancient Romans. The children will study who the Romans were and what we have learnt from them.
