Green Room


The children in Green Room have been getting into the festive spirit and have made some wooden Christmas decorations, ginger bread men and also created a wonderful gingerbread house.








Blue Room

The whole centre has visited the Schools ICT centre to do some work on STEM. We have created Lego models that had to be programmed to move and we have used computer programmes to make our own games.


Yellow Room
