Off-site sporting enrichment activities	The children in the centre benefit from the experience of off-site sporting activities which promote self-confidence and the building of a positive self-image. To access off-site sporting activities, children must demonstrate sustained positive behaviour in the centre and this contributes to children developing a positive identity over time.	£16,000	To improve positive behaviour, engagement and social development	The outdoor sports opportunities we offer contribute to a number of key outcomes. They promote a sense of togetherness and belonging amongst the group which encourages new children to take on the positive behavioral norms of the rest of the children. They expose excluded children who may have previously been excluded from school trips to a range of physical activities that they would not otherwise be aware of. They provide opportunities for personal development and growth as children gradually become more confident and experience success in the face of new challenges. It provides a dedicated time for children and staff to develop positive relationships which give

		children a toll for self-regulation in situations they find difficult.
