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Reporting to parents statement

The links and strong relationships between home-pupils and school is of high importance here at Lever Park. The triangular relationships and pastoral bonds are key to pupils achieving well.

Parents and carers receive updates about their child's pastoral and academic progress through a variety of different methods.

Phone calls

Each parent will receive at least one weekly phone call from their child's form team with updates, both positive and negative, about their child's day/week. Families also have a named contact in school that they can contact if they wish to discuss any matters at any time.

Home visits/Parents evening

Each family will receive at least one home visit or in school parent's afternoon per term from their child's class teacher; sharing targets, data and pupil achievements.

Written reporting

A written report with updates on progress against attendance, behavior and academic targets is sent out termly by the senior leadership team.

Formal EHCP review

A formal meeting is held annually to review and discuss each pupils' Education and Health Care Plan, this is done in conjunction with the local authority.
