Academic support	<p>Have an outstanding curriculum.</p> <p>All children receive individual and clear learning targets.</p> <p>We will liaise with the mainstream school teachers regularly.</p> <p>Lessons will be engaging and appropriate to meets the needs of all our children.</p>	<p>Take an interest and support the learning of my child through the class Dojo system.</p> <p>Encourage my child to complete the weekly homework challenges.</p> <p>Encourage my child to 'read at home.'</p>	<p>Listen to staff and accept help from the staff in the classroom.</p> <p>To have a go in all my lessons and in all my work.</p> <p>To have a go at my weekly homework tasks.</p> <p>To take part in our 'read at home' scheme.</p>

Behaviour	<p>Insist on a high standard of behaviour from all children.</p>	<p>Support the school's policies and standards of behaviour.</p> <p>Encourage my child to have high standards of behaviour at all times.</p>	<p>Behave well and respect others to ensure that school is a pleasant environment to work and learn in.</p> <p>To try very hard to improve my behaviour in my mainstream school.</p> <p>To work with my mentor in my mainstream school when they visit on a Friday.</p> <p>Follow the behaviour rules on transport.</p>
Communication	<p>Report on your child's progress, attendance and punctuality weekly.</p> <p>Hold or attend meetings with the mainstream school, parents and other agencies to discuss progress.</p> <p>Talk to parents weekly and inform parents immediately of any worries or concerns where necessary.</p> <p>Support children in their mainstream schools at least two half days a month.</p>	<p>Attend all school meetings to discuss my child's progress.</p> <p>Inform school of any concerns.</p> <p>Communicate with your child's key worker weekly.</p> <p>To provide school with two up to date emergency contact numbers.</p>	<p>To share how you are feeling with school staff.</p> <p>Let staff know if I have any worries or need some help.</p>
