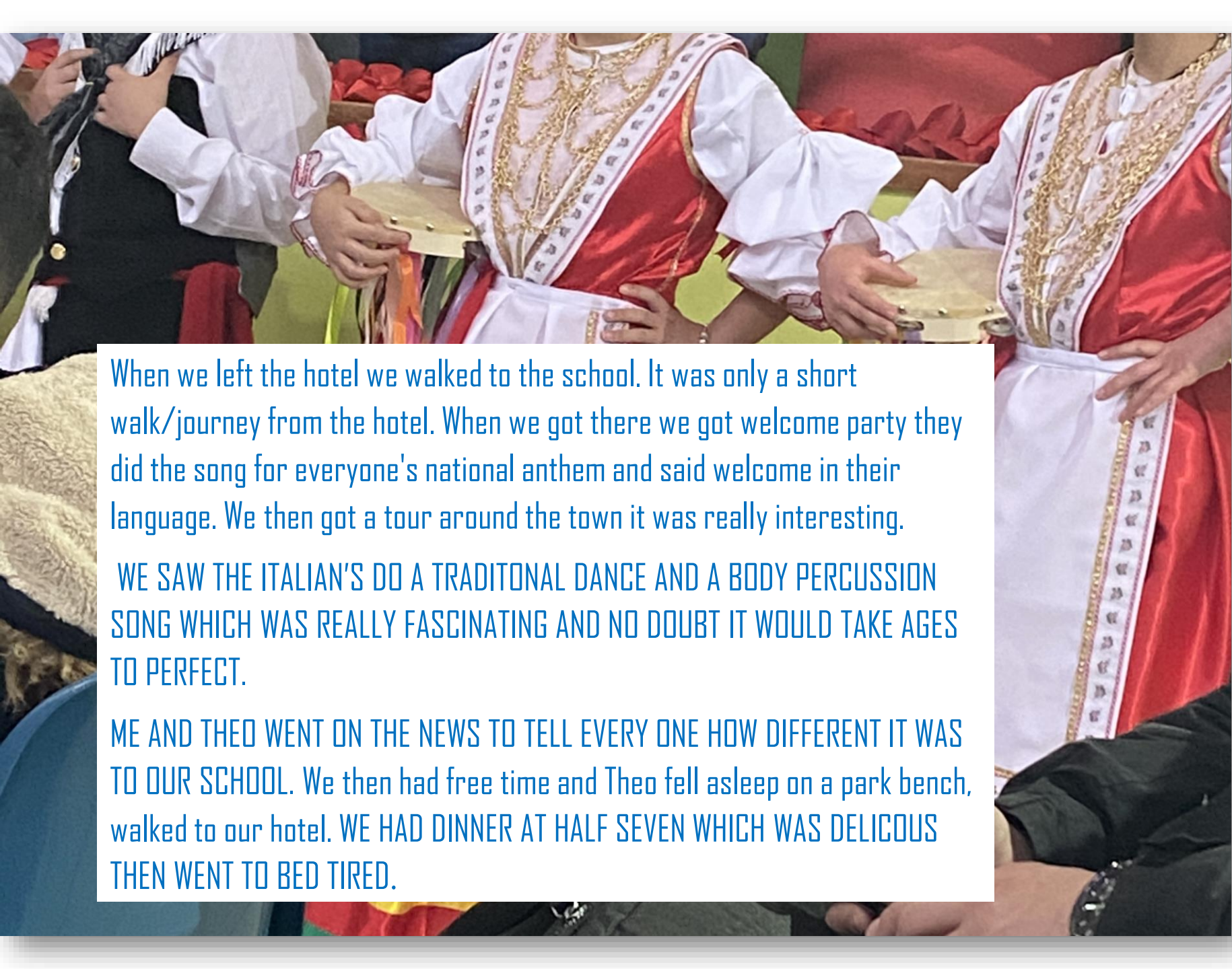

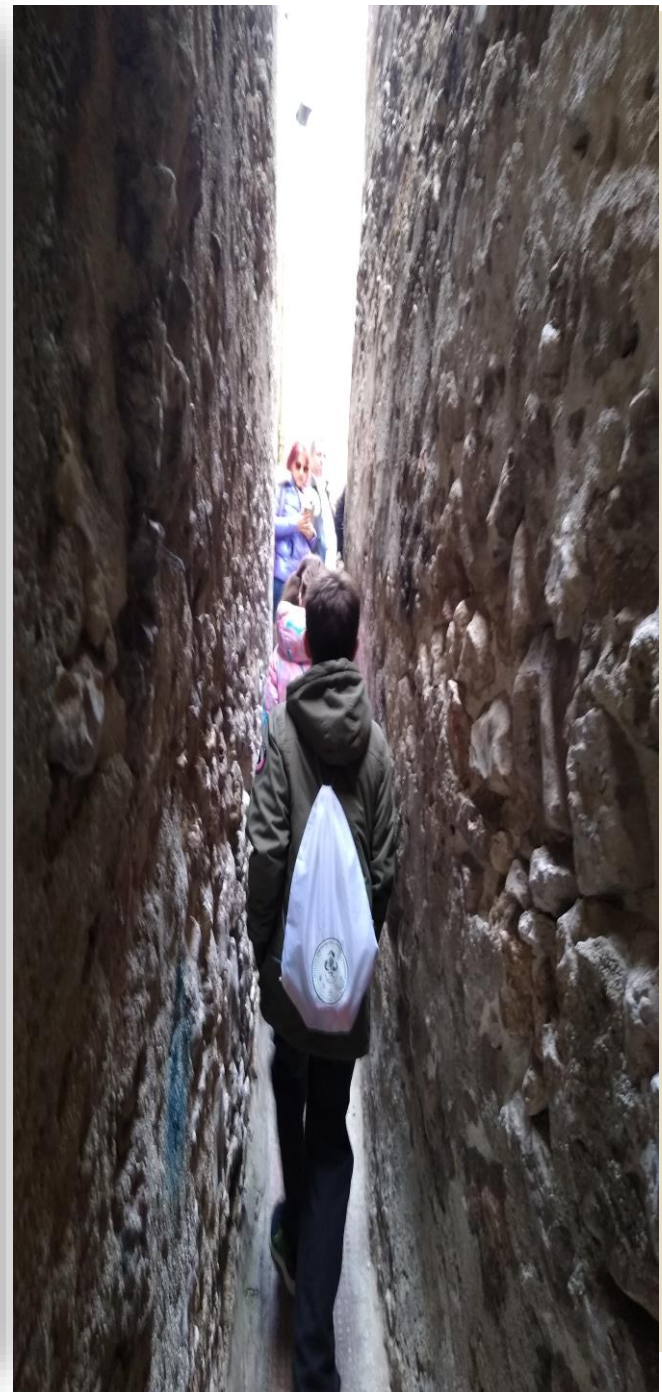

In Man Fredonia we went to a castle museum



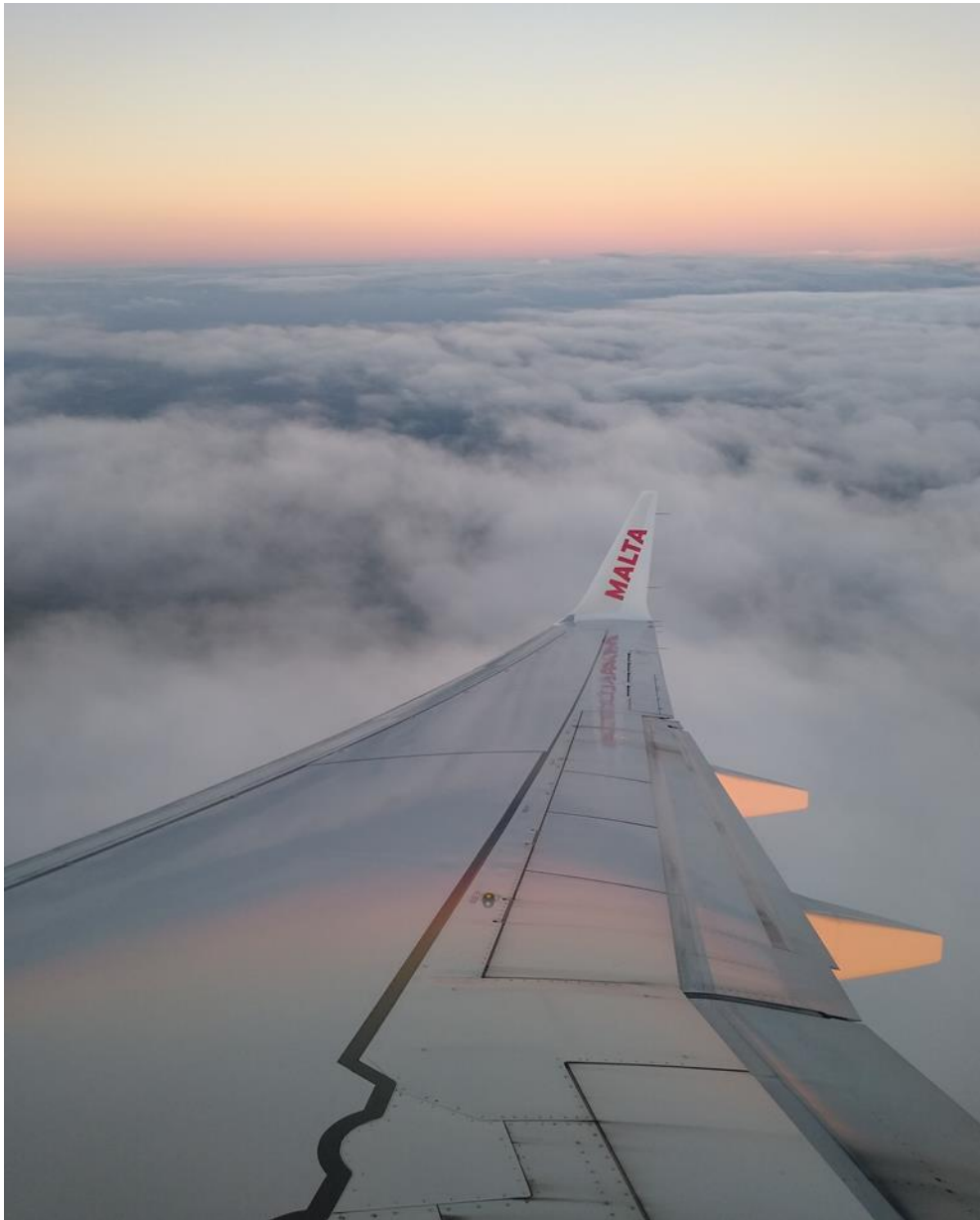
6<sup>th</sup> day
