DETAILS OF EACH EVENT AND WHAT HAPPENS NOW

Christmas hampers

Every class is creating a hamper for our Christmas raffle.

Each class has a colour theme. The idea is that the children from that class bring an item in their colour for their hamper. You can bring items in from NOW until <u>Monday IIth December</u>. We will then assemble each hamper and make them look lovely, ready for the raffle draw in the final week of term.

The children will earn 50 house points and a pompom for each hamper item they bring in.

Tickets for the raffle will be on sale at our Christmas Fayre and performances.

R	purple	Liquid soap; chocolates; biscuits; popcorn;
1	gold	Pringles/crisps; mince pies; candles; tea lights;
2	white	candle holders; baubles; tinsel; fairy lights; picture
3	red	frame; stationery, such as pens, notebooks; mugs;
4	blue	cuddly toy
5	silver	Any item in the colour of the class would be fab,
6	green	thank you!

Tip: If you can't find something in the right colour, you can wrap your chosen item in the colour for your class.

Friday 1st December: Christmas Fayre 2p.m. to 5p.m.

- The Fayre will start at 2p.m and you can collect your child/ren at 2p.m.
 to visit all of the stalls and activities.
- Parents/carers of children will need to wait outside class 5 (surnames A-M) or class 6 (surnames N-Z).
- You will need to collect your child/ren from the appropriate classroom and tick the register to sign them out. Once the children have been signed out by a parent, they are deemed to have been collected.
- You will then need to make your way round to the playground gate to enter the Fayre.
- Children not collected will be looked after by staff in classes 5 and 6 until a parent/carer arrives to take them to the Christmas Fayre.
- Santa will be here, a separate letter advises how to book a visit to see him!

Sunday 3rd December at 9.30a.m.: Boughton Church Christingle Service

Please note that this date has been organised by church, not school; there fore we are unable to change it.

All are welcome; a separate letter will be sent out to parents of children in the choir who will be singing at the service.

Wednesday 6th December: Choir singing at village hall

This will take place within the school day. Parents of children involved will have a separate letter with the relevant information.

Chartwells are providing a Christmas lunch for the children.

Reception and Key Stage One party afternoon 19th December

Reception and Key Stage One children have a party afternoon, which will take place on Tuesday 19th December. The children can come to school in party clothes on that day. During the afternoon they will take part in party games and have some yummy treats.

The Reception, YI and Y2 teachers will be in touch with parents nearer the time if there are any additional details that you need to know.

Friday 15th December: Whole School trip to The Deco to watch the pantomime

Key points to note:

- 1. This is a whole-school trip; we will be out until around 1.30p.m. No children will be able to stay in school as all the staff will be going; when we leave at 9.15 the school will be locked until our return.

 Therefore, if you have opted for your child not to attend, an absence form must be filled in.
- 2. There will be no hot dinners on this day. Chartwells will be able to provide a packed lunch instead. If you have already booked a hot dinner this has been changed to a cheese roll packed lunch. If you do not wish your child to have this option, please cancel the order by Tuesday 21st November 2023 and provide a packed lunch from home.
- 3. As we will have lunch at school, children bringing packed lunches can bring their usual lunchbox to school.
- 4. The children will have an ice-cream (or dairy-free option, in the case of dietary requirements) at the theatre.
- 5. We will leave school promptly after registration; please ensure your children arrive at school by 8.55a.m. We will arrive back at school in the early afternoon and will have lunch when we return.
- 6. The school day will end at the normal times, 3.20p.m./3.30p.m.

Wednesday 13th December and Thursday 14th December

Christmas Performances: 6.30p.m. on Wednesday, and 2p.m. and 6.30p.m on Thursday. Please note that all children are needed for all performances. A separate letter will be sent to parents with information about obtaining lickets.

To ease traffic congestion, we have the following plan for the evening performances:

- As in previous years, evening performances will start at 6.30p.m.
- Please note that we are unable to accommodate babies or preschool aged children at the evening performances. Parents are welcome to bring babies or pre-school aged children to the afternoon performance, as there is usually more room at this.
- There will be a "drop-off window" between 5.45p.m. 6.15p.m. to allow parents who are not staying for the show to get in and out of the village before those who are parking and staying. We strongly suggest that parents arrange to car share if at all possible, taking it in turns to drop off or pick up.
- Children attending After-School Club can get changed at school and will not need to be collected be fore the performances.
- To ease congestion at the front door, we are using the Y6 classroom door as the entrance for children from 5.45p.m.
- Staff will greet the children at the Y6 door and bring them to the classrooms.

- If you are coming to watch an evening performance, the front door will open at 6.15p.m. and you will be shown to your seats.
- We anticipate that each performance will last around an hour.

PLEASE RETURN ANY UNUSED TICKETS TO THE SCHOOL OFFICE. This is because we always have a waiting list and will issue tickets to families accordingly.
