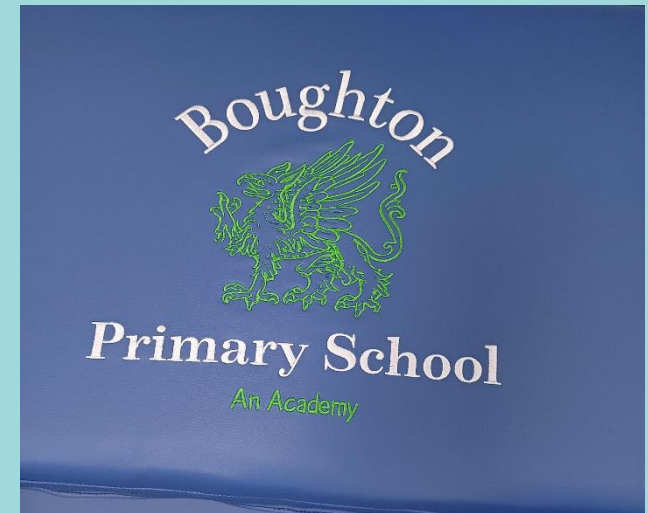

Ofsted's view of our Reception Provision


Children in the early years get off to a good start.


