#### **ARRANGEMENTS FOR THE CHRISTMAS PERFORMANCES 2023**

To save a few minutes at the start and end of each performance, I am not going to say very much. This is my Christmas gift to you all! Instead, I've tried to include the details within this letter.

## **Housekeeping**

The nearest toilet facility is next to the hall.

#### **Fire Safety**

We are not expecting the alarm to sound, but if it does, please follow the procedure below:

- Please wait for the hall lights to be switched on.
- Please exit via the doors at the back of the hall. Two of these will be opened for this purpose, one to the left and one to the right.
- Assemble on the astro pitch. This will be lit for the evening performances. Parents should go to the **furthest** goal post on the astro.
- Teachers will follow their usual procedures for evacuating classes. Teachers are in charge of their classes at this point and will need to register them on the astro. Parents will be told when to collect their children, once it is safe to do so.

#### **Photographs and Videos**

We do allow parents to take photos and videos during all of our productions and assemblies. We just ask that you are considerate to other people watching the show and also consider the safeguarding of all of our children.

With that in mind:

- Please keep your phone close to you and don't block anyone else's view of the show
- Please only share if you have the permission of **EVERY** child's parent in your photo or video.

Thank you very much for your co-operation in this matter.

### **Collection arrangements**

Parents will be asked to leave via the hall **fire exit doors** onto the playground, which will be lit, and make your way to the usual collection points. The **playground gate will be opened** at the end of the show. Reception/KS1 parents who are collecting but not watching the evenings will enter via the playground gate. Please ensure that whoever is collecting your children knows where to go, and let us know who to expect. Many thanks in anticipation of your support.

As always, the production is a massive team effort. Every member of staff contributes, by writing the script; preparing the music; helping the children to learn lines and songs; supporting individuals who are anxious about performing; supervising the children in between scenes; preparing the programmes; setting up the hall and managing the box office.
