# Christmas Play Advance Notice

We have decided not to hold any late evening performances this year. This is for several reasons, including how tired the children can be when staying late after school; difficulties with children not coming back for evening performances (last year this was around 30% in some classes); and the inevitable issues with parking and traffic, especially on the dark December evenings.
