Thursday, 12th December 6.30pm

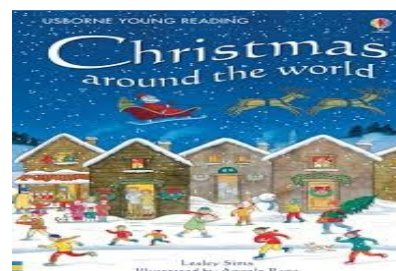
## Mrs Dunn
