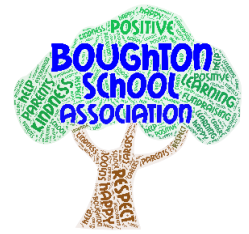


CONSTITUTION



8. Committee meetings shall be held at such times and places as the Committee shall direct.
9. The Annual General Meeting of the Association shall be held during the Spring term of each year.
10. Eight members shall constitute a quorum at the Annual General Meeting.
11. The Committee shall have the power to co-opt members and to appoint any sub-committees as deemed necessary.
12. No alteration of the Constitution may be made except at the Annual General Meeting or at a special meeting called for this purpose. No alteration or amendment shall be made to the objective clause or dissolution clause which would cause the Association to cease to be a Charity at Law.
13. The Treasurer shall keep an account of all Income and Expenditure and shall submit accounts, duly audited, at the Annual General Meeting. The Banking Account shall be in the name of the Association and withdrawals shall be in the name of the Association on the signature of any two of the following:-

14. An Auditor, not being a member of the Committee, shall be appointed annually at the Annual General Meeting to audit the Accounts and Books of the Association.
15. Any assets remaining on dissolution of the Association after any outstanding debts and liabilities, shall be distributed by the school for the benefit of the children of the school, in any manner which is exclusively Charitable at Law.
16. The Head Teacher shall have the ultimate decision on all educational matters.
17. Any matter not provided for in the Constitution shall be dealt with by the Committee, whose decision shall be deemed final.
