Year 6 – Cooking Competition



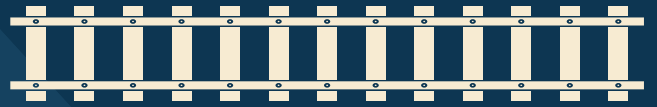
The Year 6 Cooking Competition saw its last round before the final last week.
